

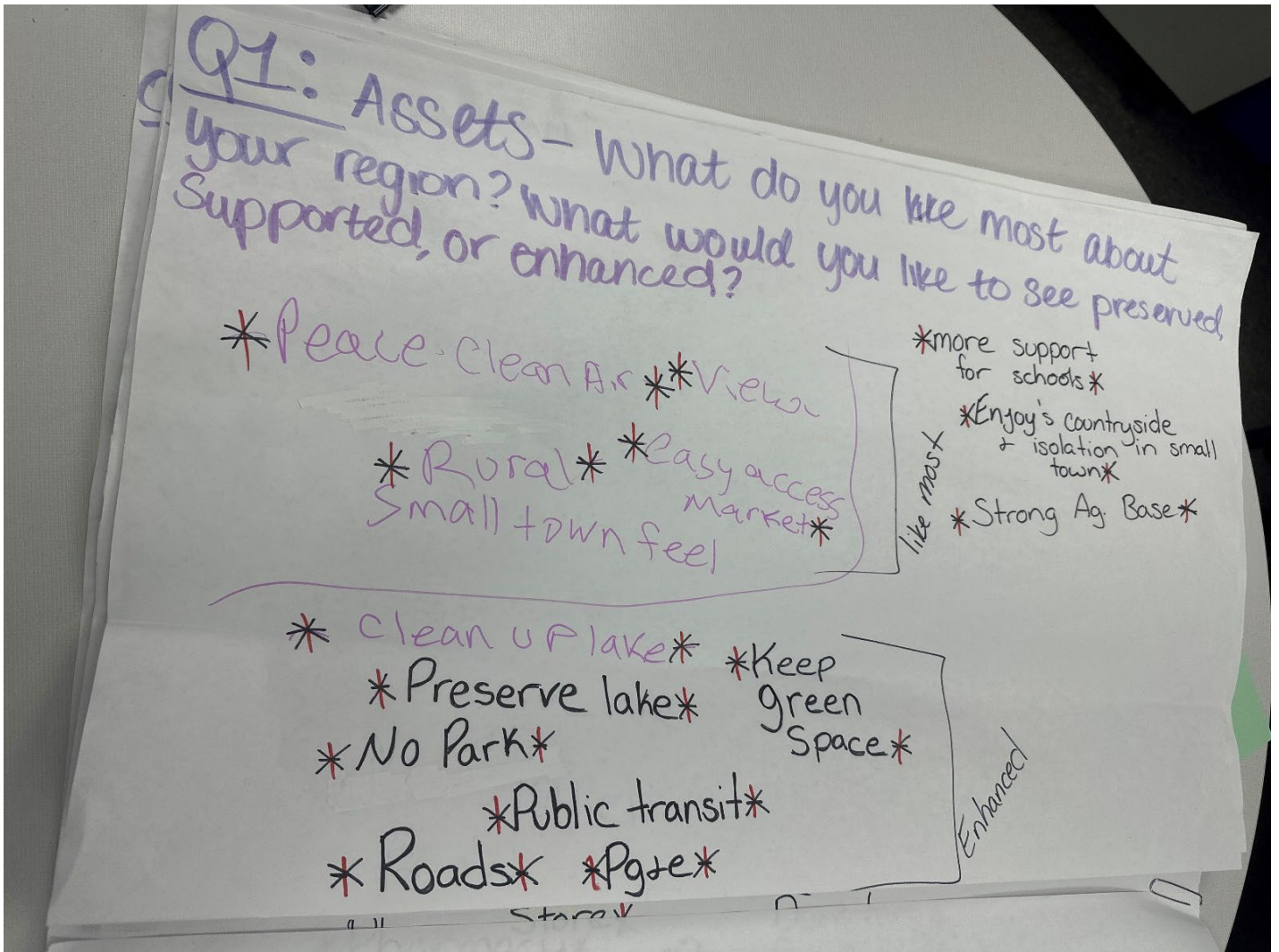

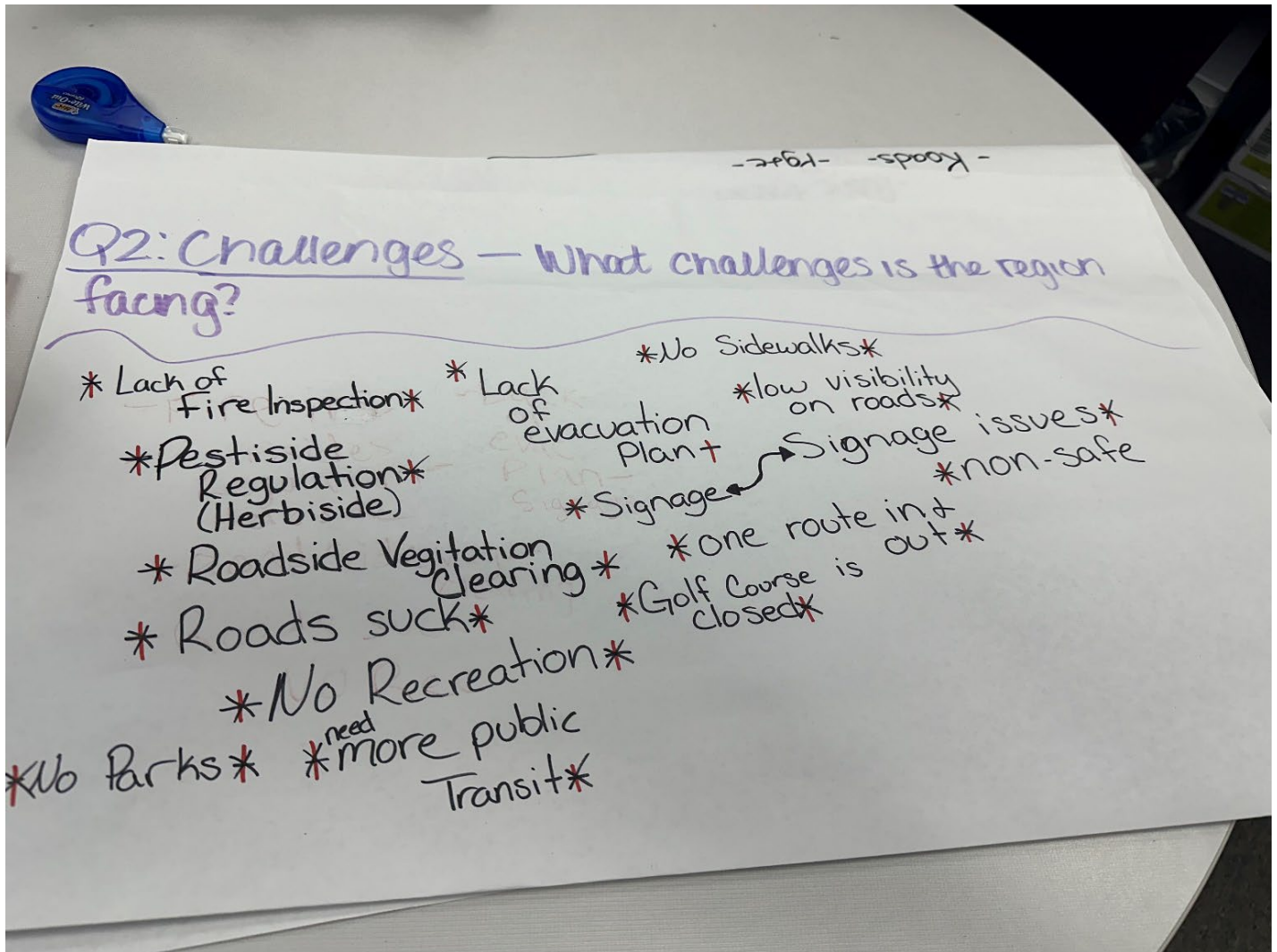
Q1: Assets - what do you like most about your region? What would you like to see be supported, preserved, or enhanced?
